
Please join us next Thursday, June 17 at 6:30 PM

flashlights, etc. Bus pass: \$15.75


#### **FOR WOMEN**

Towel sets (2 wash cloths, 1 hand and1 bath towel), soap, shampoo/conditioner combo, hair brushes, toothbrushes and toothpaste, Shaving cream, razors, deodorants, hand cream, Tampons, note pads/pens/etc., calendars

**Spring**: socks, tee shirts or blouse, rain jacket, umbrella

**Fall/Winter:** socks, sweatshirt, gloves, scarves and knit hats. Any extra items like wallets, small purses, make up bags, etc.

### For In-Person Worshiping

We have worked hard to make sure that safety protocols for our church members are met and in place during these Covid times. Below is what we have implemented per CDC guidelines.

- 2 large air filtration units for air purification and circulation with medical grade filters
- 1 air purifier in the choir loft
- Plexiglass shields on each podium and in front of the choir loft
- The pews are sectioned off f or the social distancing
- Everyone is still required to wear masks
- We will enter the church from the side door at large parking lot side of the church
- We will leave the church from the large doors in the back of the church
- Your temperature will be taken when you enter the church
- If you plan to attend every Sunday, please let Jennifer Ramsay or Nancy Allen know. This way you do not have to pre-register through the church office
- At this time, we can have 25% of our normal capacity of 224 which is 56 people
- Hand sanitizers are there when you walk in and in the back of church
- There are arrows (one way only) for walking to follow for safety social distancing
  - 1. The Center aisle one way towards the back of the church
  - 2. The Right and Left side aisles are from the back to the church to the front.
